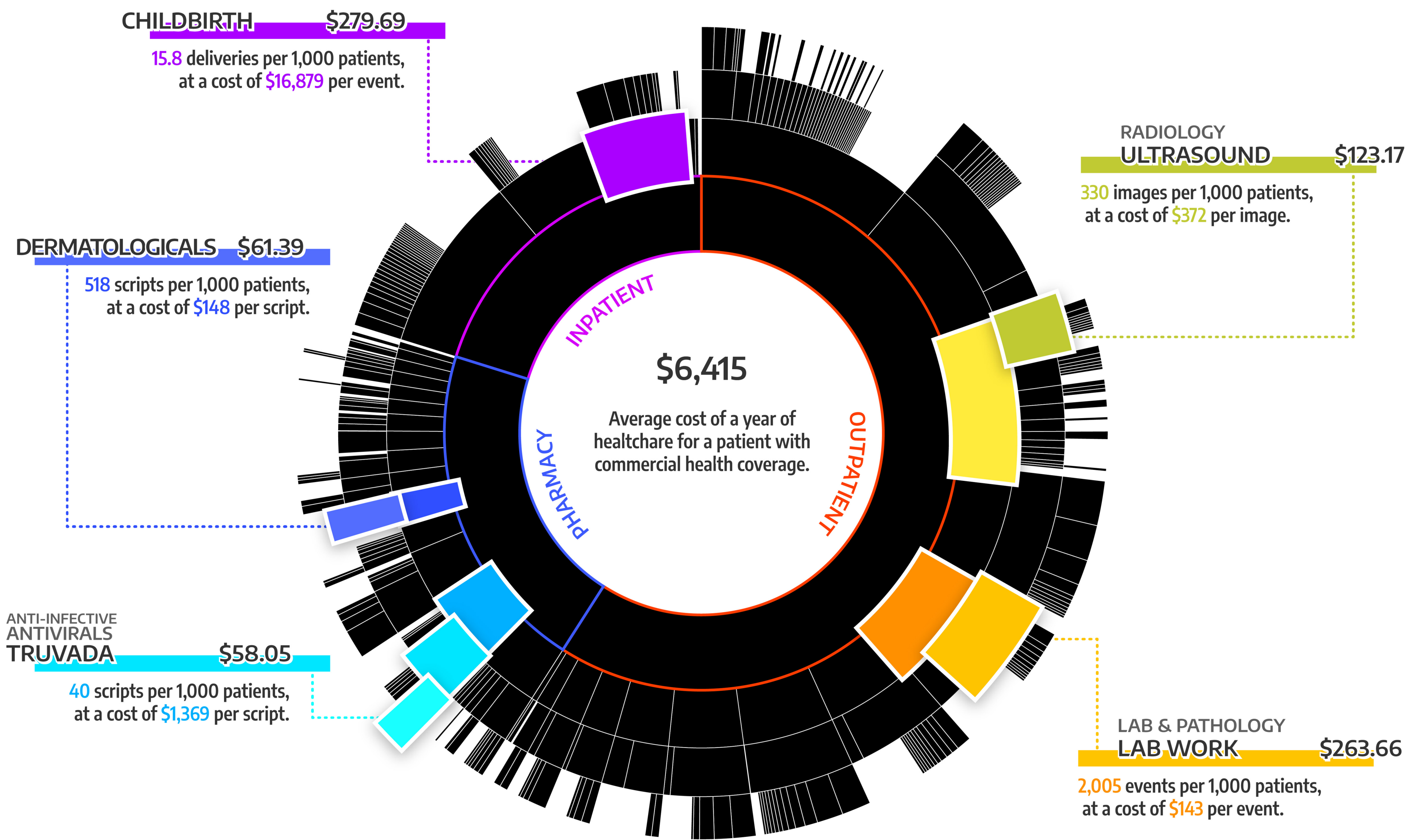


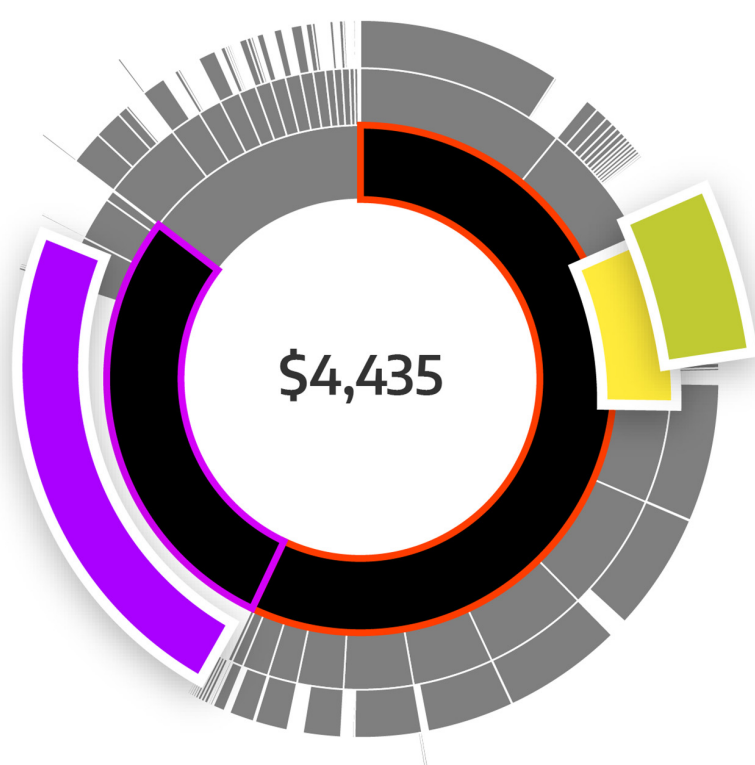

CATEGORIZING 500 MILLION CLAIMS

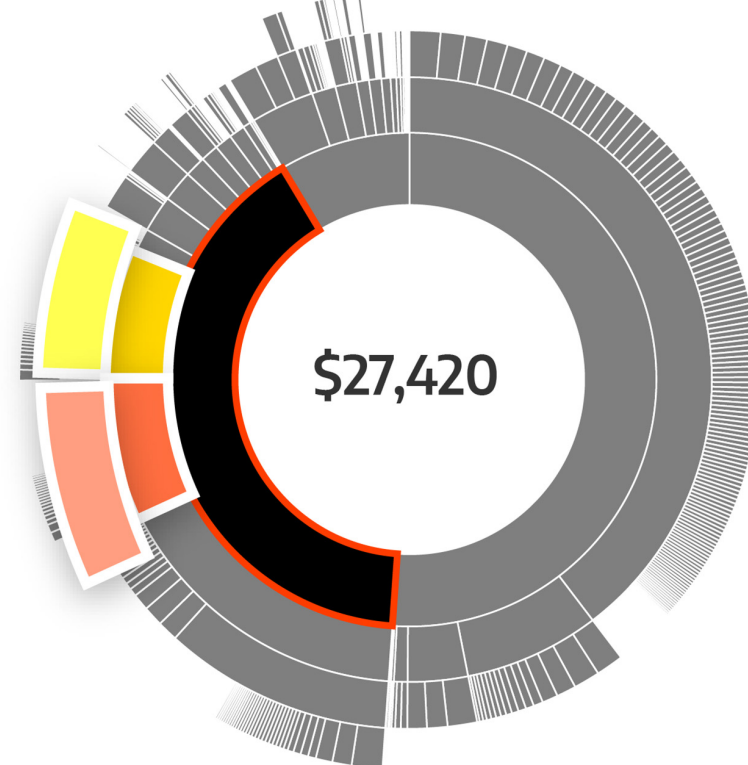


INDIVIDUALIZED COST PROFILES

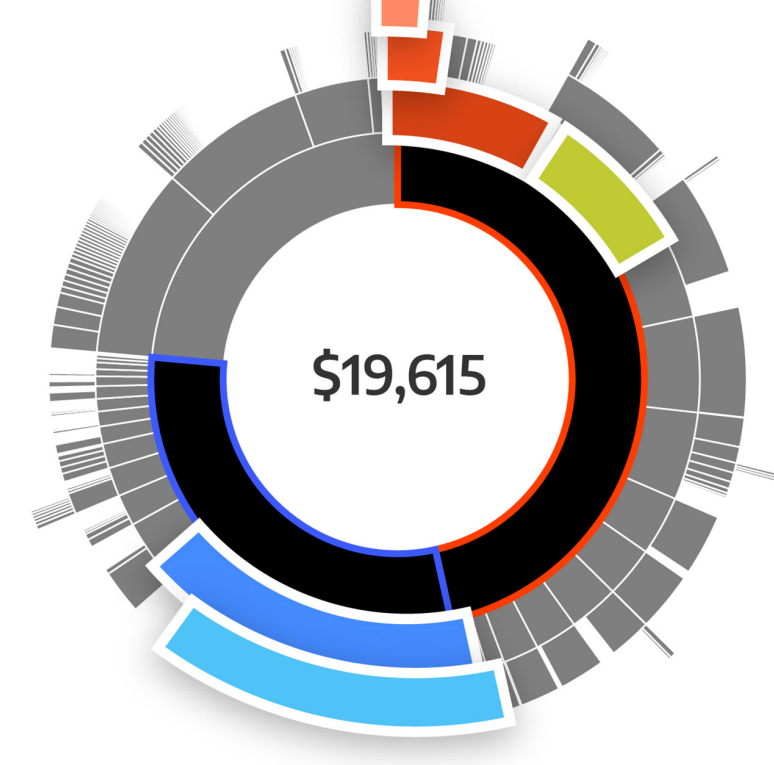
WOMEN 25-35Y
Over 25% of population costs are in **maternity** and **ultrasound**.



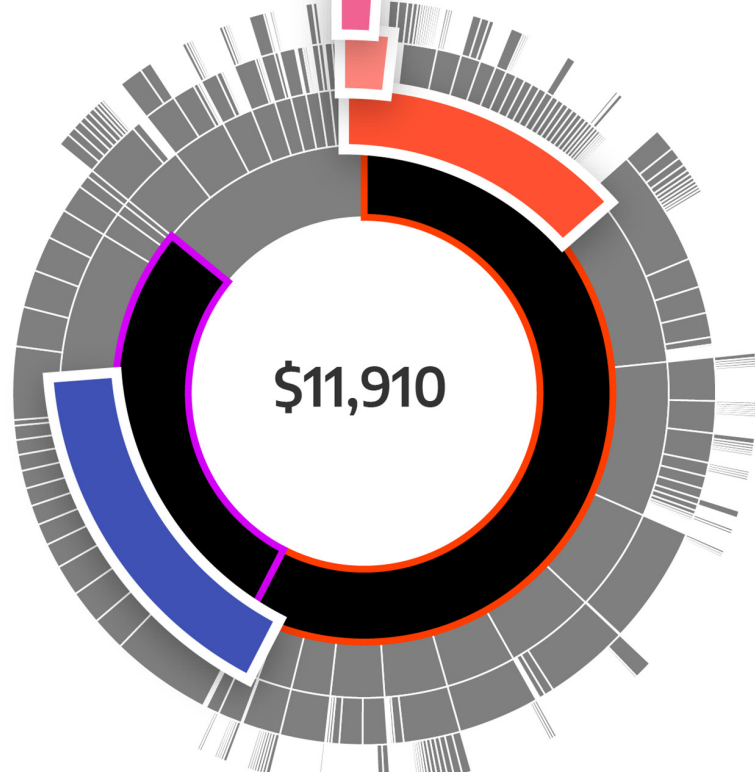
SEVERE SUBSTANCE ABUSE
Rates of **emergency room** and **ambulance** services nearly 4x the average.



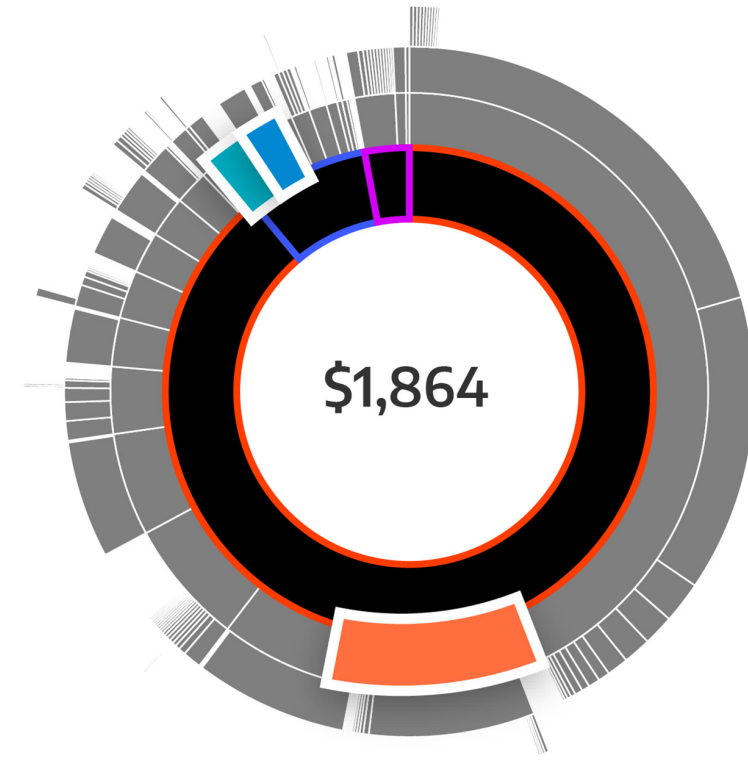
COMPLICATED DIABETES
Dialysis is 2.5%, and **med pharm/DME** is 2x more than average. **Oral therapies** are 14%.



HEAVY TOBACCO USERS
Gallbladder removal is a common procedure. Costs for **inpatient medical stays** are 4x higher.



CHILDREN 5-12Y
Almost entirely **outpatient**, high volume of **ED Visits**. **ADHD** and **asthma** meds are common.



DIAGNOSED ALCOHOLICS
High hospitalization costs for **liver disease**. High **ED** use, increased **antiviral medications**.
